A bilingual French - English pathway conforming to the French national program, leading to the French Baccalaureate or French International Baccalaureate bilingual French-English (BFI);

A bilingual Portuguese-English pathway conforming to the Portuguese national program, which, starting Year 8, goes towards an international pathway following the Cambridge curriculum, leading up to the IB Diploma Program (IBDP), through iGCSEs.

Options for transitioning between the two educational pathways;

The development of an exclusive pre-university STEEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Ecology and Mathematics) programme in partnership with the Instituto Superior de Agronomia de Lisbon (ISA).
